PUPIL'S CHARTER POLICY

This Charter states that all pupils/students may reasonably expect:-

1. to be treated with respect as persons;
2. to enjoy the benefits of equal opportunity and access to learning experiences;
3. that the school will make available to them through the whole curriculum, skills and experiences as a preparation for a full life in their communities and in advanced society;
4. to acquire an understanding of their cultural heritage and to consider their role in its maintenance and development;
5. that their general education will equip them for entry into the world of work and give them an adequate basis for further/higher education and training;
6. to be given an awareness of spiritual values, to gain knowledge of religious beliefs and to examine their significance for daily living;
7. to receive an impartial political education appropriate to participation in the life of democratic society;
8. to be treated as responsible partners in their own education;
9. to be treated with understanding and compassion as individuals, receiving impartial counselling and guidance;
10. to receive regular reports on progress, culminating in a comprehensive Record of Achievement/Progress File at the end of compulsory schooling;
11. to be educated in safe, clean, comfortable and well maintained buildings and to be supported by appropriate human and material resources;
12. that the school in turn will expect their regular attendance, positive attitudes to learning and their whole hearted involvement in the life of the school as a community.
